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INTRODUCTION

For 12 years, Running To Stop The Traffik (RTSTT) has worked tirelessly with one goal in mind: pioneering and mobilising a new generation of changemakers to put end to slavery once and for all.

Some people might think that the goal of advocating the freedom of 40 million people is a little audacious. We agree. But the stakes are too high to set modest goals. We are proud of the way our young leaders have charged headfirst into this mission.

Are we close? No. Will we stop anytime soon? Not a chance. One thing we know is that every life impacted is one step closer to a world where slavery no longer exists.

This past 2021/22 academic year, we have worked intensely with 131 young pioneers to organise our signature large-scale, anti-slavery events. They also spearheaded dozens of educational conferences, workshops and programs where we work closely with schools and organisations working with youths.

While we are still feeling covid's impact, 2021/22 was a record-breaking year for RTSTT. For the first time in our history, we held eight races spanning across three continents.

Together with A21, we have been able to break ground in Pattaya, Thailand to rebuild the Child Advocacy Centre (CAC). The CAC is designed to assist officers working on the ground in conducting cases against child sex offenders, child traffickers and online crimes against children. This year we aim to fully fund the US\$ 100,000.00 required to see this rebuild through and with your support, we are confident we can make that happen.

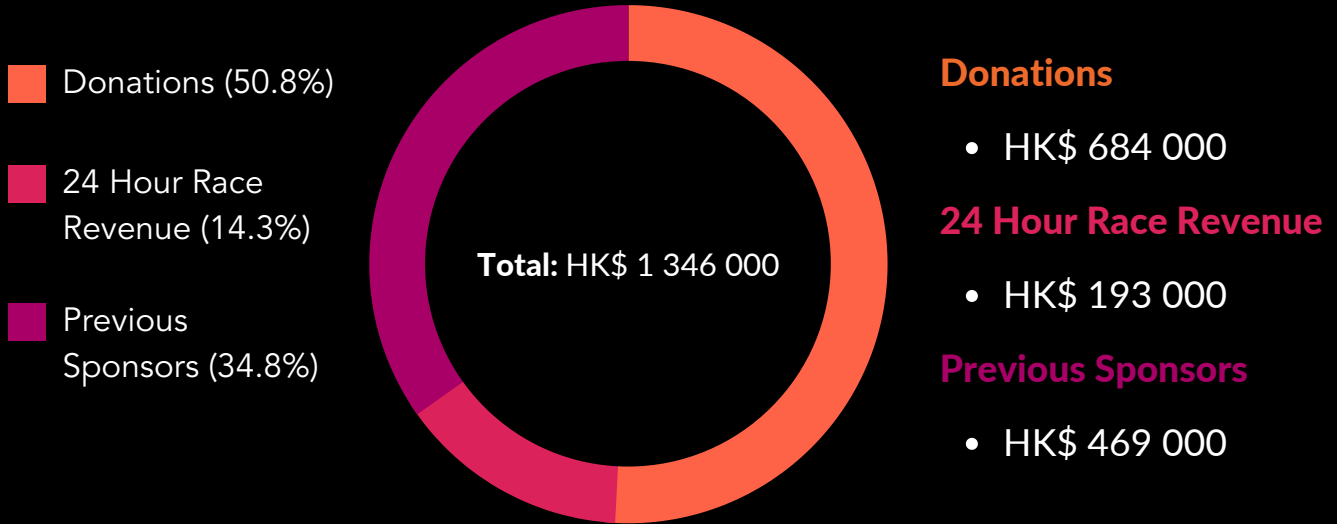

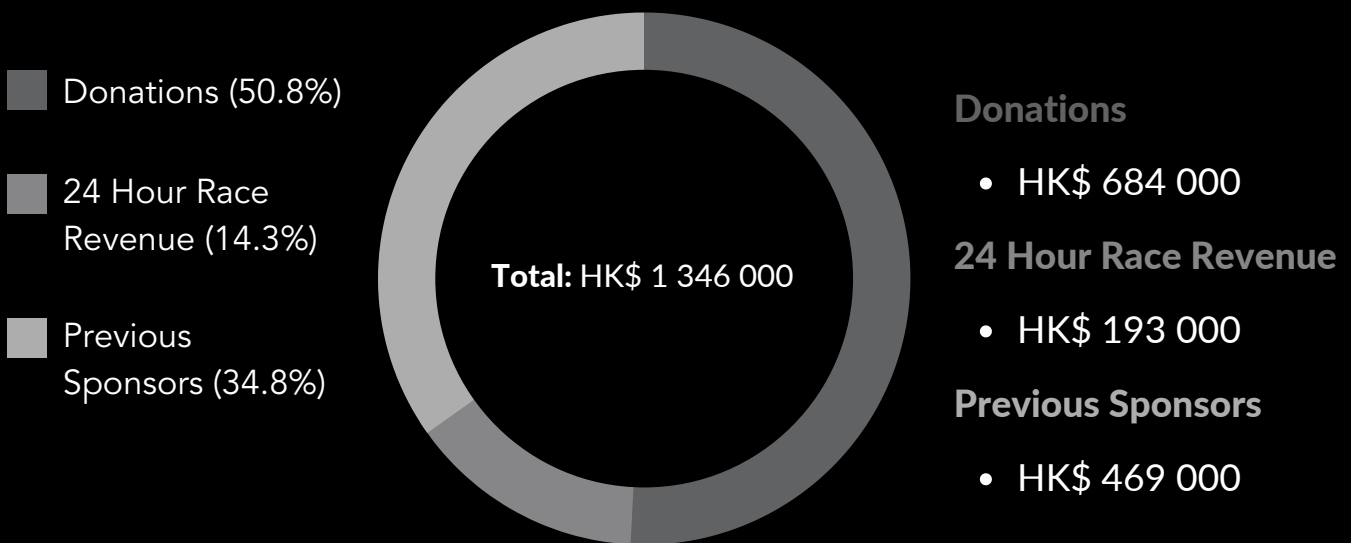

Global Revenue | September 2021 - August 2022 (Update needed)

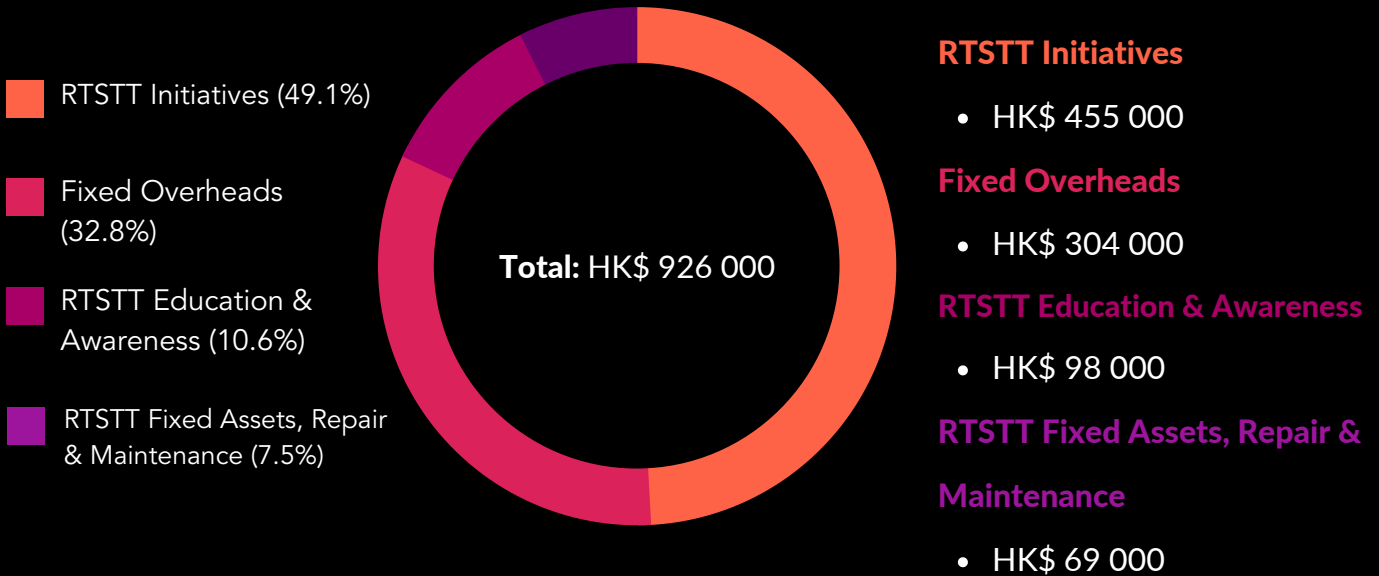


Global Revenue | September 2020 - August 2021

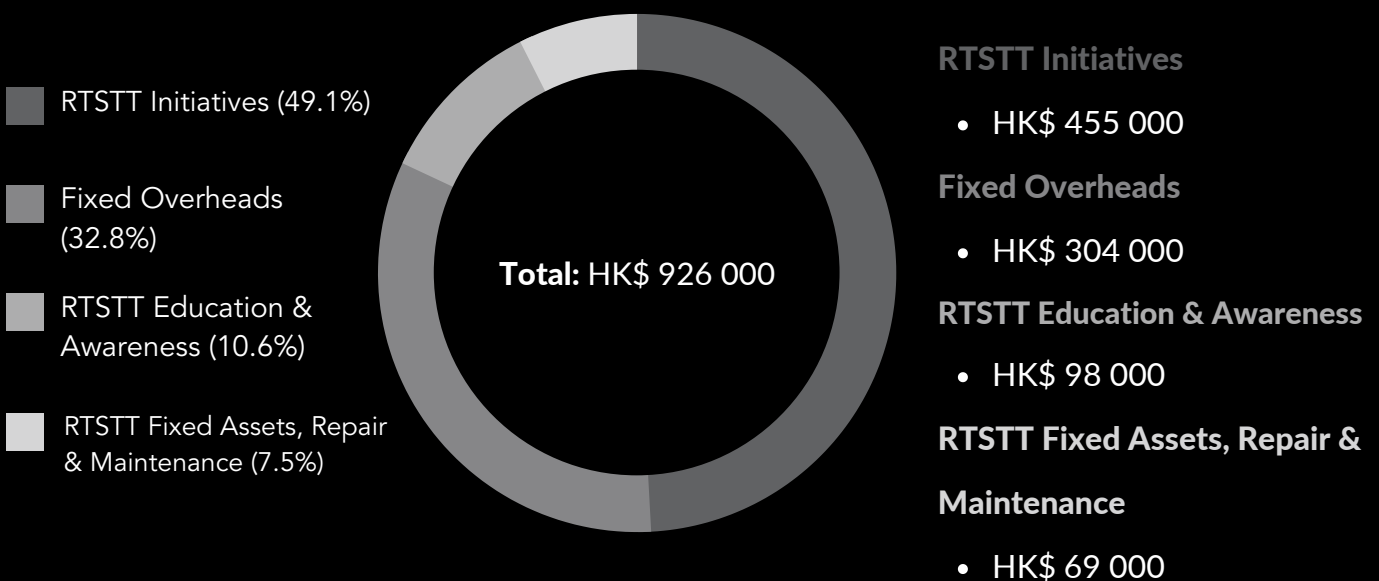

Freedom. That's our goal for every human being on the planet.

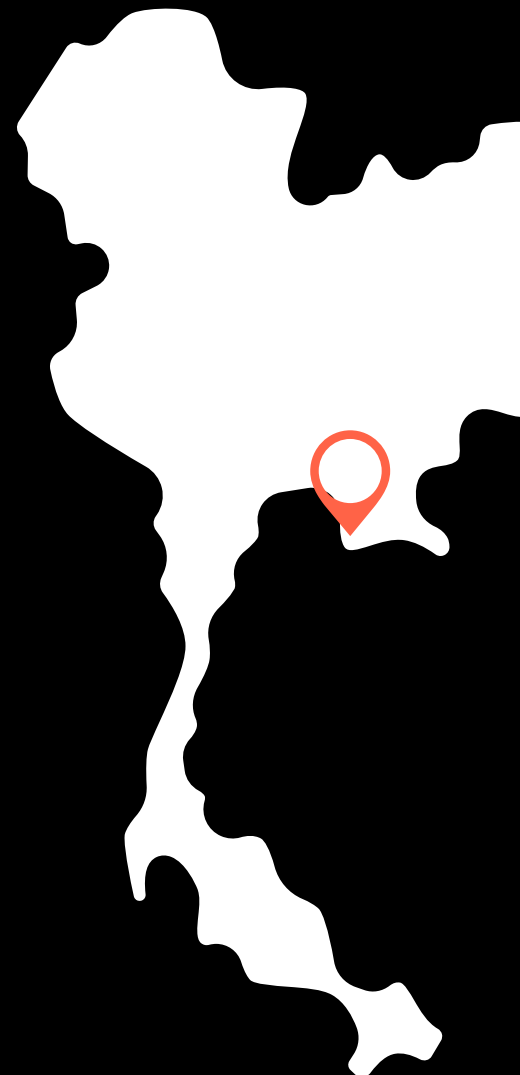
Mission: Abolish slavery everywhere, forever.

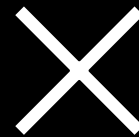
IMPORTANCE OF OPERATIONCAC

OperationCAC is a long term partnership with A21 to deliver a global blow to human trafficking.

The CAC Pattaya is designed to assist officers working on the ground in conducting cases against child sex offenders, child traffickers and online crimes against children. The CAC model creates a safe environment where child victims of trafficking and sexual exploitation are able to speak to forensically trained interviewers about trauma they have experienced or witnessed. Furthermore, the CAC in Pattaya is equipped to provide skills and educational training to at risk families and survivors, in addition to professional training to first responders and professionals working in the child protection field.

We are more excited than ever to get started with our fundraising project. OperationCAC will help bring much-needed aid to A21's work in Pattaya, Thailand. Together with your support we can bring hope to men, women & children, and help them start a new page in life with opportunities of survival, recovery, and hope.

This project needs USD 100k from start to completion in order to be successful.

LEADERSHIP CYCLE

1. RECRUITMENT

Roles on the Organizing Committee are headed by the Executive Director; Business Development Director; Operations Director; Community Director; and Marketing Director. Each Director works with 3-4 role-specific Committee Members who make up the remaining spots of the Organizing Committee.

2. SOCIAL ENTREPRENEURSHIP

This is an opportunity for members of the OC in each country to be part of an international coalition of impressive student leaders, to learn from each other and develop their skills leading up to the 24 Hour Race. We aim to provide seminars, trainings, and placements in internships with partner organisations for OC members, in order to develop their business acumen in fields related to their functional role.

3. FUNDRAISING AND AWARENESS

Leading up to race day the student leaders organises awareness events at their schools, a speaking tour that sees us fly someone from HQ over to talk about modern slavery and the 24 Hour Race, and other advocacy-oriented events. In addition, we work with
